"Think about the different kinds of plants and animals God made. Task 3 (15 minutes)

promises. Read **Genesis 9:12-16** to discover the reminder, and then draw a picture of His promise."

"Repeating verses out loud helps us memorize them. Practice this skill by reading **John 3:16** our loud several times."

Some ideas to help with memorization: 1. Write the verse on a dry-erase board. As the students learn parts, erase a word at a time and have them repeat it again. Keep erasing until all the words are gone and the students are saying the verse by memory. 2. Have them repeat the verse each time using a different accent or style of talking until it is memorized (southern, British, valley girl, as loud as possible, as quiet as possible, underwater/finger wiggling on their lips, etc.)
