Transportation Ministry

Job Description:

Transportation ministry is responsible for getting members safely to the corps and returned home after programs. This ministry will include use of the buses and other corps vehicles.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Must be 21 years of age or older
- · Must have a valid Drivers License & clean driving record
- · Must fill out and have approved Driver form with Phyllis
- Be able to pick up, drop off, and communicate with corps members
- Keep proper mileage charts for vehicles and maintain vehicle rules and cleanliness

Teaching Ministry

Job Description:

Those in Teaching Ministry will be responsible to teaching and leading Sunday School classes each Sunday morning. Teachers will be provided with material and are expected to prepare for their class each week, present the lesson, clean the classroom, and keep track of attendance using the Sunday School cards.

- Knowledge of the Bible and evidence of a personal relation—
 ship with God
- Ability to read, interpret, and teach Scripture and lessons in a creative way
- Prepared—have materials and lesson plans ready for each week
- Reliability—weekly attendance at church, advance notice if not able to attend, providing materials for replacement
- · Participation in quarterly Sunday School Teachers' meetings

Youth Ministry Assistants

Job Description:

Those involved as Youth Ministry Assistants will be responsible for attending Wednesday Night Youth programs and assisting the leader with supplies, behavioral management, cleanliness, and other needs.

- Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Ability to attend Wednesday night youth programs from 5 6:30 pm
- Reliability—able to attend each week and communicate with leader if unable to come in advance
- · Passion for young people and youth work

Community Care Ambassador

Job Description:

Community Care Ambassadors will be responsible for going out in the community and visiting those who are sick either at home or in the hospital, shut-in, or in nursing homes and prisons.

Ambassadors will distribute War Cry magazines, good cheer, and the love of Christ.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Ability to travel to and from nursing home facilities, walk hallways, and carry War Crys
- · Friendly and inviting spirit and actions
- Ability to communicate with Corps Assistant/Corps Officer
- Ability to keep records for statistics (dates, times, number of rooms visited)

Prayer Warriors

Job Description:

Prayer Warriors are the church's first line of defense against the enemy of evil. Prayer Warriors will be responsible for diligence in praying for the corps, its needs, and the surrounding community.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Awareness and involvement in the life of the corps and corps members
- Able to pray for the corps: leaders, members, programs, work, community, needs of others— sickness, health, jobs, families, etc.

Communication Ministry

Job Description:

Those involved in Communication Ministry will be responsible for following up with guests who attend the corps each week, members who were not in attendance, reminders for corps members, and celebration cards.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- · Access to a telephone
- Ability to write, address, and mail cards, letters, and postcards

Mercy Seat Ministry

Job Description:

Those involved in Mercy Seat Ministry will be responsible for praying with seekers at the altar or holiness table at any time during the meeting.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- · Active prayer life
- Ability to get up quietly during meetings
- Ability to kneel or bend to pray with people
- Communication skills—access the need of the seeker and pray for those needs

Penitent Form Sergeant

Job Description:

The Penitent Form Sergeant will be responsible for overseeing the Altar Ministry and keep accurate record and statistics for seekers.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Attendance at church each week, and notification in advance of planned absences with replacement
- · Ability to keep name records and seeker statistics
- · Report statistics to Captain Elizabeth Juliana weekly

Hospitality Ministry

Job Description:

Those involved in Hospitality Ministry will be responsible for maintaining the appearance of the Hospitality Table in the chapel by keeping it stocked with the most up to date publications, greeting people as they enter for worship, and directing newcomers to the appropriate Sunday School class.

- · Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- · Ability to locate new publications and re-stock table as needed
- Ability to greet, communicate, and direct to the appropriate
 Sunday School class
- Direct guests to fill out the "Guest Information Card" on the table
- Be reliable in attendance and presentable in appearance

Ushers

Job Description:

Ushers are responsible for assisting people who may need help finding a seat before the meeting, making sure everyone has a bulletin, taking up offering as needed, and making sure the chapel is cleaned (papers picked up, songbooks put away, etc.) and rows are straightened after each

meeting.

- Evidence of a personal relationship with God
- Ability to identify open seating and guide people to those seats
- · Ability to locate bulletins and make sure each person has one
- Ability to pick up trash, replace songbooks, and straighten chairs after meetings
